



GMB Scotland Local Government Pay Petition

For the last ten years council workers have been at the coalface of the austerity agenda. Jobs, pay and conditions have been hammered after consecutive years of pay freezes, below inflation pay awards and savage budget cuts.

Early next year, local government trade unions will negotiate with COSLA to set local government pay for 2018/19. GMB is clear: It's time council workers received a proper pay rise. Ahead of the joint trade union pay submission to COSLA, GMB is campaigning for:

- A £2.00 an hour increase across all local government pay grades;
- A £1,000 lump sum to address real-terms pay losses since 2008; and
- A guarantee of no compulsory redundancies.
